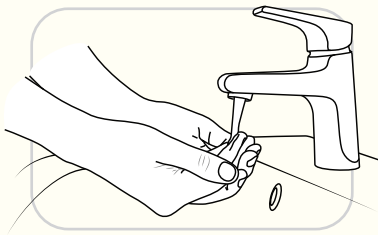
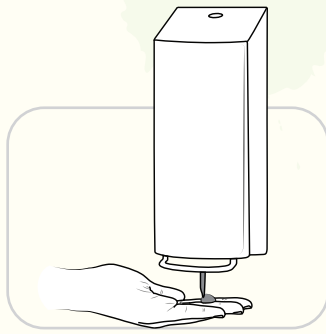


HOW TO WASH YOUR HANDS

Apply soap



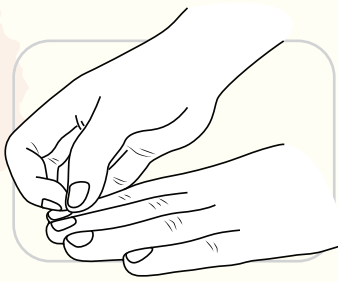
Rub palms together



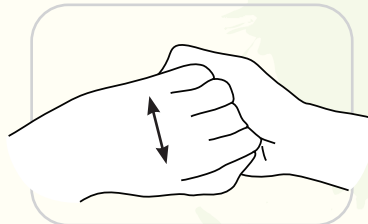
Clean backs of hands and fingers.



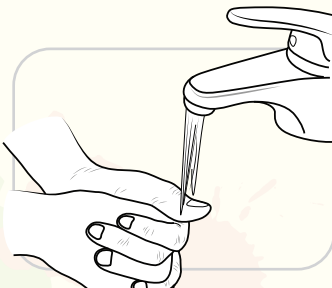
Clean between fingers



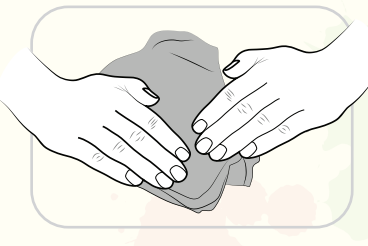
- Clean fingernails -



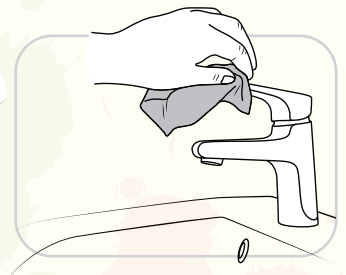
Clean thumbs

- treating a wound

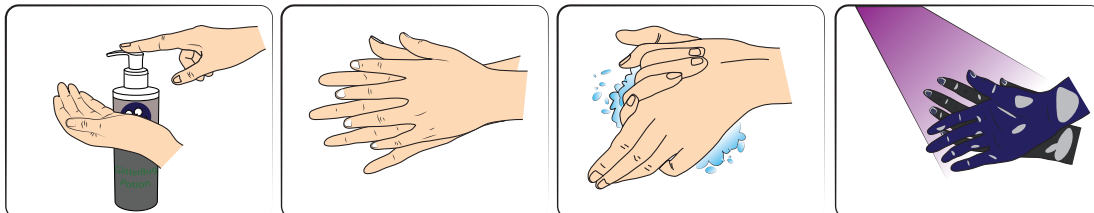
